What is it like to learn art at Sheriff Hutton Primary School?

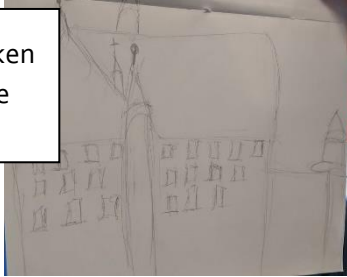
Art is taught through both discrete lessons and our thematic approach. Some aspects are linked to curriculum topics, other aspects are focused on artistic styles and specific artists.

Collage using natural materials created some great effects.

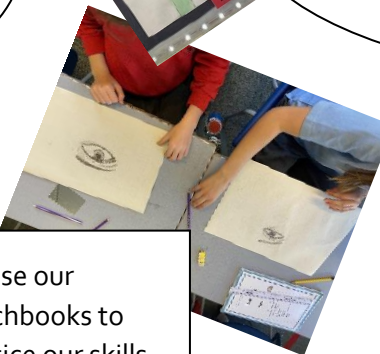
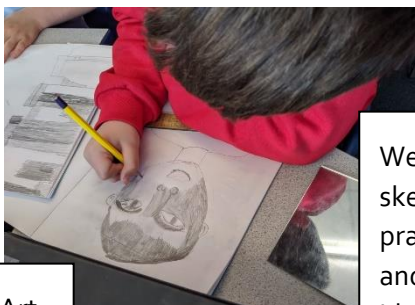


There is an after school club every week focusing on arts and crafts.
