We study a wide range of high quality texts throughout the school.



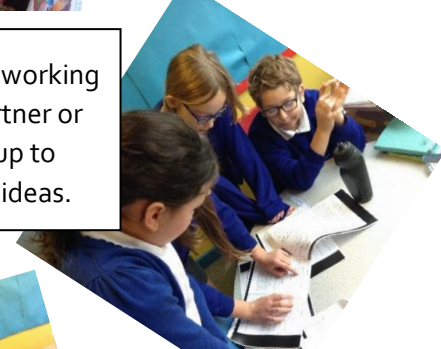
We enjoy reading to others as well as independently.



We record our learning in different ways.



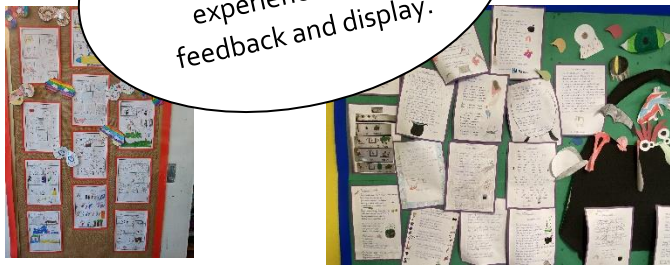
We enjoy working with a partner or small group to share our ideas.

We like performing our poems and participating in drama activities.

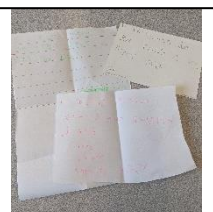


Every class has a working wall, which helps to support our writing development and highlights high quality vocabulary.

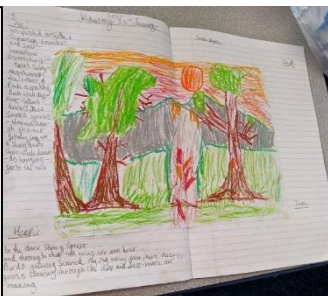
Letters to the Queen.



Letters to Mrs Pearson.

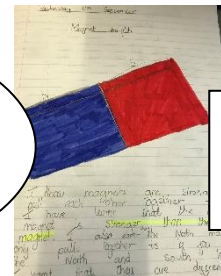


Some of our sessions are not linked to a theme; they focus on discrete learning such as grammar or a specific genre.
