We follow the White Rose mixed aged planning scheme for maths teaching and learning.

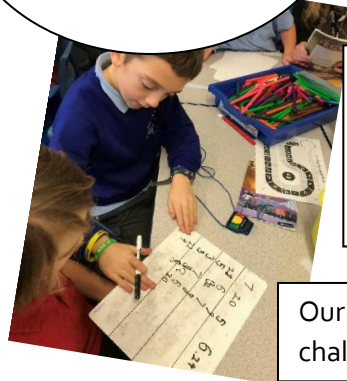
This is supplemented with challenges and further opportunities from NRICH and other resources.



We have access to practical equipment to support our learning.

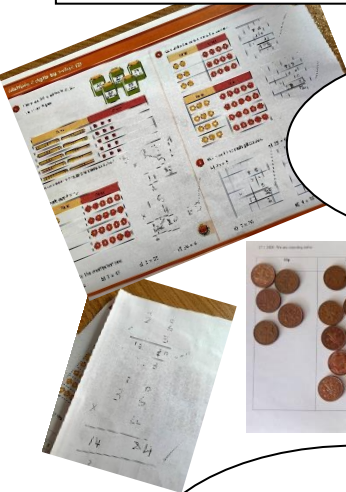


We enjoy working with a partner or small group to share our ideas.



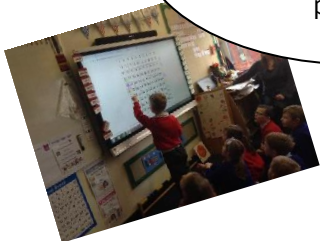
Our lessons are challenging.
